
Corvinus Excursion to Esztergom - 1 MAY 2019



During our excursion, we are going to travel from Budapest to Sturovo (Slovakia) by train. In Sturovo, a local sightseeing train will wait for us, having a short journey to Esztergom, so we spend just little time in Slovakia.

In Esztergom, participants have free time until the departure of our regular boat line (16.00) back to Budapest. The boat trip takes app. four hours.

During our trip, you are supposed to get a picture about cross-border cooperation of these cities, about their struggle for growth and investments, and about other socio-economic developments of Central and Eastern Europe.

1) Traveling

Meeting point: Nyugati Pályaudvar, before platform 11, 8.00. Do not be late!

8.41-9.46: Budapest-Sturovo, by EC Varsavia.

10.00-11.00: Sturovo-Esztergom by local sightseeing train.

11.00-16.00: Free time in Esztergom, during which students have to conduct an appr. 1,5 hour walking seminar.

16.00-20.00: Esztergom-Budapest by boat (Mahart-Passnave)

You do not need to buy tickets, it is bought by Corvinus University.

You need to bring your: ID CARD, STUDENT CARD.

2) What else to bring?

Please check the whether before traveling! Please be aware that we are going to spend four hours in a boat (which has indoor rooms, anyway), but **cloth for cold whether seems to be reasonable**. Please bring money or/and food. Esztergom is littered with restaurants and cafes. Unfortunately, the buffet service of the boat is underdeveloped, offering just chips and beverages for a 4-hour long journey.

Please **bring your smartphone charged, and your earphones**. Why? Because outdoor educational material is uploaded to a training application called **Peripatos**. Within Peripatos, you can find:

- **Danube Bend Tour** (train guide from station Vác to Sturovo) about the past and present of Central and Eastern Europe
- **Esztergom Tour** (walking guide about such socio-economic phenomena which can be detectable in this city). You can form 3-4-person groups or just walk alone along the tour, as you wish.

3) What else to prepare?

- If you have good camera and can make good photos or films, we are more than grateful!
- Please download Peripatos to your smartphone in advance.
